Even with the unique challenges caused by COVID-19, we continued to share our energy with the communities we serve through charitable giving, outreach and employee volunteerism.



Serving 297,000 natural gas and electric utility customers in 119 communities, our direct economic impact in Colorado included franchise fees, charitable giving, compensation to more than 470 Colorado employees, payments to suppliers and property, sales and use taxes paid.
