At the same time that the Settlement or Issues List is filed, the Parties are directed to notify the Commission whether they will proceed with the live hearing, waive the live hearing, or submit to a paper hearing (with suggested procedures).

The public evidentiary hearing on BHEA's Application for a change in rates is scheduled to begin at **9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, August 30, 2022,** to be held in the Commission Hearing Room located in the Arkansas Public Service Commission Building, 1000 Center Street, Little Rock, Arkansas.

The Public Comment Hearings on BHEA's Application are scheduled to begin at **6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 6, 2022,** at the Fayetteville Public Library, Willard and Pat Walker Community Room, 401 W. Mountain St., Fayetteville, Arkansas, and at **6:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 8, 2022,** at the Blytheville High School Auditorium, 600 N. 10th St., Blytheville, Arkansas.
