## DEFINITION OF CSG LOW-INCOME SUBSCRIBER AND CONDITIONS

- A Low-Income CSG Subscriber is defined as: (1) non-profit affordable housing or public authority housing<sup>1</sup> for low-income residents only; or (2) low-income occupants of single family housing, where "low-income" is further defined as less than or equal to 185% of Federal Poverty Level ("FPL") consistent with Colorado law;
- For any Low-Income CSG subscriber from <u>non-profit affordable housing</u>, all residents must meet the low-income definition and must be the beneficiaries of the CSG subscription;
- For any Low-Income CSG subscriber from <u>public authority housing</u>, all residents must meet the low-income definition and must be the beneficiaries of the CSG subscription, and the public authority housing must receive electric usage bills directly from Black Hills;
- For each Low-Income CSG Subscriber, there must be a completed and fully-executed Low-Income Subscriber Agency Agreement submitted by the CSG Subscriber Organization to Black Hills Energy;
- For each Low-Income CSG Subscriber, there must be a completed and fully-executed "Consent to Disclose Utility Data" form submitted by the CSG Subscriber Organization to Black Hills Energy. Access to the form and instructions for use are located on the Black Hills website.
- All Low-Income CSG Subscribers must be Black Hills retail electric service customers in Colorado;
- Each Low-Income CSG Subscriber's retail customer premise must be located in the same county, or adjacent county, as the solar garden; and,
- No one Low-Income CSG Subscriber can have an allocation higher than 40% of the total garden.
