Location: Firestone, CO

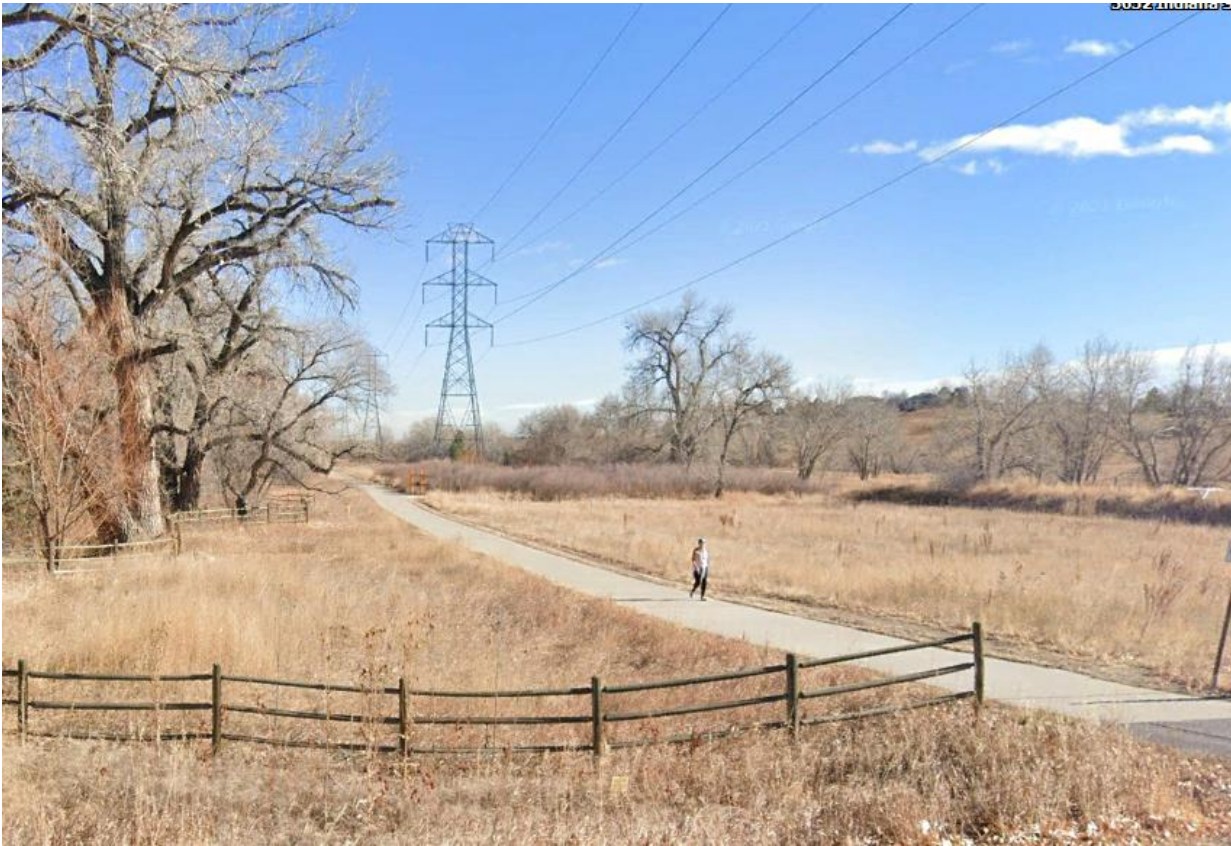
Note: Underground portion located between structures 47 and 48.

Project: Tap-Ridge and Lookout-Ridge 230kV Lines
Owner: Public Service Company of Colorado
Location: Arvada, CO



Facility: Del Camino Tap-Meadow (115kV) & Fordham-Fort Saint Vrain (230kV)
Owners: Tri-State and Platte River Power Authority
Location: Longmont, CO



Facility: Desert Cove-Midway (115 kV) and West Station-Midway (double circuit 115 kV)

Owners: Black Hills and Xcel Energy

Location: Pueblo West, CO

Note: Pueblo West Metropolitan District owns the utility corridor and installed the powerline trail. It is approx. 1.5 miles between E. Sapinero Drive and E. Desert Cove Drive.
